

# Historic Copper Corridor Drive



**Saturday, April 14<sup>th</sup> - 8:00 am - ALL DAY!!**

During the fairly short drive from Winkelman to the northern flanks of the Santa Catalina Mountains, you meander through the Sonoran Desert, skirt the riparian corridor along the San Pedro River (which is dry) and drive past historic mining towns such as Oracle, Winkleman, Mammoth, Dudleyville, Kearny, Hayden and ending in Superior. With a (1) hour tour of Kannally Ranch in Oracle State Park.

Meeting place: behind Jack in the Box ( in the Lowe's parking lot) - S/W corner of Arizona Ave/Ocotillo in Chandler. In Fulton Ranch Town Center. Take the 202 San Tan freeway. Exit at Arizona Ave and go south about 4 miles to Ocotillo

Drivers meeting: 7:45am

Leave promptly: 8:00am

Kannally Ranch Tour: 10:00 in Oracle State Park - cost \$7.00/car to enter the park. Tour is free.

Lunch: 11:30 - La Casita in Mammoth (Authentic Mexican food). The only American food available is chicken tenders/fries. If you don't like Mexican, feel free to bring a picnic lunch.

Mining Memorial: 1:00 - a brief walk from the restaurant to a park. A nice tribute to those who lost their lives during the decades of copper mining.

Leave: 1:30

Arrive in Superior 2:30 (then you will be on your own)

Have a full tank of gas, bring an FRS radio if you have one and please bring \$7.00/car cash ready to enter the Park. Since this is an all day run, you may want to pack some water to drink.
